# Call for Applications

### What's MED-Y.C.I ?

**Mediterranean Youth for Creative Impact** is a 30-month project (August 2025 - February 2028) funded by the EU under the Interreg NEXT MED Programme.

Led by **Les Têtes de l'Art** (France) in partnership with **CILG** (Tunisia), **Anna Lindh Foundation** (Egypt), **IEMed** (Spain), and **Pi Youth Association** (Türkiye).



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## Who are the beneficiaries of the project?

The project supports **young Mediterranean people** to develop creative, digital, and civic skills that strengthen their employability and active participation in society.

## What are the objectives of the project?

Through innovative training programmes, creative studios, and hands-on youth-led actions, MED-Y.C.I offers young people the tools, space, and confidence to turn ideas into impact while contributing to more inclusive and sustainable communities across the Mediterranean.

The MED-Y.C.I programme combines creative skill development, civic engagement, and youth-led social innovation.

## What are the project activities?

The project includes a variety of youth activities, including:

- Participation in training workshops on relevant issues
- Strengthening key skills including digital skills, creativity, communication, leadership, and intercultural dialogue and soft skills
- Joining Mediterranean youth groups and networks
- Participating in dialogue spaces and experience-sharing among Mediterranean youth
- Develop and produce impactful audiovisual and digital content
- Proposing youth-led initiatives and recommendations.



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## What are the application requirements and evaluation criteria?

Applicants must be between 18 and 30 years old.

Applications will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- The applicant's experience in producing visual or digital content
- The applicant's willingness to learn and develop audiovisual skills
- The applicant's motivation to participate in the project
- The applicant's personal vision regarding intercultural dialogue
- The applicant's opinion on the role of youth in strengthening intercultural dialogue
- The applicant's spoken languages.

The evaluation process will take place in the following stages:

- **Stage1:** Verification of compliance with the application requirements and eligibility criteria. Only eligible applications will proceed to the next stage.
- **Stage2:** Screening of applications and initial selection based on the evaluation criteria mentioned above.
- **Stage3:** The CILG International team may conduct interviews with shortlisted candidates to confirm the information provided in their applications. Final selection decisions will then be made. All applicants will be informed of the final results by email during April 2026.

**Please note:** Failure to respond or providing incorrect information may result in the rejection of the application.



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## How can you apply for the project?

Young people in Tunisia who wish to participate in the project must fill out the application form in Arabic or [English](#).

- Applicants are also invited to submit a short presentation video (maximum two minutes), or choose one of the following options:
  - A short written response
  - An audio message
  - Another creative format (for example, a small portfolio or a photo-based story)

All application formats will be evaluated using the same criteria.

Note: If the video option is chosen, a simple recording using a mobile phone is sufficient. The technical quality of the video will not be evaluated.
